**ACOM Solutions, Inc. Buys Assets Of New Times Med, LLC,
Creates Healthcare Division To Market Medical Reports System**

LONG BEACH, California and Tampa, Florida, January 5, 2005 -- ACOM Solutions, Inc., a world leader in the development and marketing of solutions to optimize business back office processes, has acquired the assets of New Times Med, LLC and has created the Electronic Medical Records (EMR) Division to market the company's software to chiropractic and other diagnostic and/or treatment-related health service providers, it was announced today by Gregory T. Church, the ACOM vice president charged with oversight for the division's operations. Terms of the acquisition were not revealed, since both companies are privately held.

The chief asset acquired by ACOM is RAPID EMR, a software system that enables practitioners to input diagnoses, patient treatment plans, notes, progress evaluations and other information onto a tablet computer, during the actual patient visit. Input can be accomplished using standardized checklist templates, descriptions and handwritten notes, as well as by keyboard.

From the combined input, the system uses integrated formats to generate concise, easily readable reports for insurance companies, attorneys and other involved parties, including cash-paying patients. Meanwhile, practitioners can reduce the amount of time devoted to report preparation by as much as 90 percent through RAPID EMR's automation capabilities, Church said.

"This acquisition represents a major new opportunity for ACOM," he said. "In effect, it extends ACOM's general expertise in optimizing back office processes to a specialized field with pronounced needs for greater efficiency. RAPID EMR's focus to date has been on the chiropractic community, but the basic engine of the software can be applied in other areas of the healthcare and therapy fields as well. It is well-known that healthcare costs are rising while providers simultaneously are under intense pressure from the costs of delivering care.

"RAPID EMR has already proven its value in keeping the back office costs of chiropractors under control while

actually helping to increase the ability of practitioners to see more patients and spend more time with each one." According to Church, Division operations will continue to reside in Tampa under the direction of Cesar Barragan, founder and president of New Times Med. Plans call for retention of all New Times Med staff as well as for enlargement of facilities and a phased increase in the division's development and support staff.

ACOM is an employee-owned company that has experienced consistent year-to-year growth and which has been continuously profitable for more than 10 years.

According to Barragan, the new arrangement will enable him and his associates to more quickly fulfill long-term objectives.

"We know from relationships with our customers and others that the RAPID EMR system has enormous potential for application in many sectors," he said. "As a part of ACOM, we gain the advantages of a well-funded company with expertise selling into a variety of markets and we will also benefit greatly from the availability of a seasoned management team."
