As a [web-based document management system](#) it is compatible with all computing platforms and software, storing and managing data from any internal or external source, with the special capability of accepting documents of any kind automatically and directly from other ACOM solutions. Auxiliary devices include a browser and a scanner for hard copy document input and internet connection.
